If an abstract is accepted, please click on the button 'more information' and inform us by 25 October 2021 at the latest if you agree to present this abstract. Also make sure that you are registered via <https://registrations.emuc.org/registrations> (early registration fee applies).

As an e-poster author, you are requested to upload a Poster PDF to a protected server of M Events Cross Media GmbH prior to arriving to Athens. You will receive an e-mail soon from M Events with a dedicated link where you can upload your Poster PDF.

Your Poster PDF will be on display from Thursday 25 November until Sunday 28 November 2021 as electronic poster in the e-poster area on electronic screens, and your poster will also be available online at www.emuc.org.

The scientific committee will review all EMUC e-posters onsite during the congress, and **6 best EMUC e-posters** will be selected. The presenters of those 6 abstracts will be invited for an oral presentation, either on Saturday or Sunday. The winners will be notified during the congress via e-mail and they will be requested to give a short presentation about the abstract on the stage of the main auditorium. Winners will receive a certificate for their achievement.

Please note the following instructions for the Poster PDF:

- > Only PDF format will be accepted
- > No videos are accepted
- > Posters should be in **portrait (vertical)**
- > Posters attached to e-mails cannot be processed
- > Only 1 poster PDF file per abstract

Do's

- > Make your poster visually interesting
- > Your poster should follow an easy to understand format i.e. methods, results and conclusions
- > Keep illustrative material simple when using charts, graphs, drawings and pictures
- > e-Posters (in .PDF-format) should be self-explanatory and will be used to expose your findings to congress delegates
- > Use some colour combinations that provide better contrast such as white on black etc.

DONT'S

- > No need to bring a printed version of your poster, it will be e-posters only
- > Do not use projection equipment (projectors are not supplied)
- > Do not over-elaborate everything on your poster
- > It is not possible to bring small leaflets of your poster, there is no location where these can be placed
