If an abstract is accepted, please click on the button 'more information' and inform us by 12 October 2026 at the latest if you agree to present this abstract. Also make sure that you are registered via <https://registrations.emuc.org/registrations> (early registration fee applies).

We would like to ask you to put up your poster in the poster area for the duration of the whole congress. Your poster will be on display from Thursday 5 November until Sunday 8 November 2026 as a physical poster in the poster area on poster boards.

The EMUC Congress Office has chosen to offer the innovative web-based platform, PosterSessionOnline, to organise printing of posters for this year's event. This service receives, prints and then delivers your poster to the congress venue, thus guaranteeing all posters arrive in perfect condition. Please note that this service is optional, feel free to bring your own poster to Brussels.

Please note the following instructions for the poster:

- > Posters should be in **portrait (vertical)**
- > 90 x 120 cm
- > Only 1 poster per abstract

Do's

- > Make your poster visually interesting
- > Your poster should follow an easy to understand format i.e. methods, results and conclusions
- > Keep illustrative material simple when using charts, graphs, drawings and pictures
- > Posters should be self-explanatory and will be used to expose your findings to congress delegates
- > Use some colour combinations that provide better contrast such as white on black etc.

DONT'S

- > Do not over-elaborate everything on your poster
- > It is not possible to bring small leaflets of your poster, there is no location where these can be placed

FAQs:

Do I need to upload a poster online prior to the congress?

This will not be needed, we only ask for a printed poster, which you can hang on a poster board onsite at the designated poster area.

Will posters also be made available as ePosters?

Posters will not be made available online. Instead, the full abstract body will be published online in the EMUC resource centre, in the EMUC app and as an online supplement by Elsevier on European Urology Open Science. If you do not want your abstract published online, please send an e-mail to emuc@congressconsultants.com.

Do I need to use the service of PosterSessionOnline?

The printing service of Poster Session Online is an optional service, which makes the printing of posters very easy. You get to work with a standard template, and they will do the printing and delivery for you. However, it is not mandatory to use PosterSessionOnline, so you are completely free to print your own poster and bring it onsite. In this case, please keep in mind the instructions indicated in this document.

Is there a template which I can use to prepare my poster?

There is not a template available, so you are free to prepare your own poster. In case you are using the PosterSessionOnline service, there will be a template available.

How do I find my posterboard onsite?

All posterboards can be found in the designated poster area, and will be labelled with your Poster Number. Please note that this number is different from your initial Abstract ID and can be found on the Outcome page via <https://abstracts.emuc.org/>

How do I hang my poster on the posterboard?

Sticky material will be made available near the posterboard, which enables you to hang your poster.
